The Grounds: Kruger Farms

Kruger Farms is 4 miles from town – home of <https://www.krugerfarms.com> - they sell hunting gear (Sitka, Underarmor, etc.) on-site and on-line – and are home to corporate sponsored private Hunting events!

The panorama when you drive in is spectacular - grounds are lush without paths and trails – on MN “parade of prairies” – and we have a wide variety of choices to set up some challenging courses.

The Town: Starbuck, MN

Park your car at the Cedar Inn and walk across the street to the Nutcracker and Franny’s - gas station right in town for supplies – grounds are 4 miles away.

Starbuck is giddy that we are coming – they want to alert their chamber of commerce about our event!

Cedar Inn Motel is an in-town mom and pop motel – when I level-set that if he said yes to dogs that they would be everywhere – he was over the moon! (They lodge Kruger Farms hunter overflow and his Mom owns Franny’s bar)

Nutcracker Café – across the street – serves breakfast - open @ 6 AM – Friday Banquet

Deep Fried Walleye or Barbequed Pork ribs – baked or hashbrowns – salad – coffee - \$18.00

(3.2 beer or wine coolers available – look the other way if you “bring your own”)

Franny’s Bar is around the corner – we’ll congregate Sat night for burger baskets ‘on your own”
