The Central Wisconsin Sporting Spaniel Club (CWSSC) will host **TWO** Fall Field Trials for English Cocker Spaniels and Cocker Spaniels. One on Saturday September 13 and the other on Sunday September 14 in New Glarus, Wisconsin on the Oasis Game Farm property N9074 Cty Rd. J, New Glarus, WI. (Note: For the GPS use Blanchardville, WI. The grounds are west of New Glarus, off of Rt 39 and Cty Rd J) **There will be an OPEN All-Age Stake and a PUPPY Stake on each day. The PUPPY stakes will start after the 2nd Series of the Open Stakes but not before noon. Chukars will be used for both Puppy Stakes.**

Saturday's Open judges are John Hall and Lea Ames both from Chicago, IL. Sunday's Open judges are Jess Sekey of South Elgin, IL and John Hall. Both Puppy Stakes will be judged by Pete Zuleger of Appleton, WI and Ray Takmajian of Edwardsville, IL.
