The Junior Test will start promptly at 8:00 a.m. and the Senior and Master Test will follow. The test site headquarters will be at the field. Please follow the signs and orange flags to locate the field on the grounds.

*No food will be available on the grounds – please bring your own lunch, snacks and water/beverages

Directions to the grounds:

From Interstate 64 in St. Charles County, take HWY 94 south to Route D. Then 1.5 miles to the area entrance.

**More specific directions will be sent out and posted with the running order in May.*

- ✓ **Everyone must wear an article of blaze orange while in the field. A vest, shirt, or jacket is preferred. (A hat is not enough)**
- ✓ **Only flat collars are allowed on the test grounds.**
