From the PA Turnpike (I76)

Take the PA Rte 100 Exit #312 toward Pottstown/W. Chester 0.4 miles

Take the Rte 100 South ramp toward Downingtown 0.5 miles

Merge onto N Pottstown Pike (Rt 100) 0.6 miles

Turn left onto East Uwchlan Ave (Rt 113) and continue for 3.9 miles

Turn left onto Pikeland Rd, go 0.2 miles to stop sign

Turn Right onto Art School Rd and follow orange flags to the hunt site

All participants must wear blaze orange in the field and only gunners approved by the Test Committee will be used. Severe training, correcting, or disciplining of dogs will not be permitted on the Hunt Test grounds.

Standard AKC Rosettes will be awarded to all
those earning qualifying scores

There will be a limit of 50 dogs each day. Priority will be given to the Spaniel breeds (except the Irish Water Spaniel) plus Airedales. Entries will close if the limit is reached prior to the closing date. Entries will be evenly split across the two divisions, allowing for dogs that can't run under certain judges.
