

The Platte River English Springer Spaniel Club would like to invite you to the English Cocker and Cocker Spaniel field trials to be held on Thursday, March 31st, and Friday, April 1st, 2016, in Crete, NE.

We are having two open stakes judged by Rick Shively from Colorado and Tom Hartman from Nebraska. Puppy stakes will be offered on both days.

We have a block of rooms at the Super 8 in Crete, NE and their direct number is 402-826-3600. The rooms are held under "Cocker Spaniel Field Trial". The room rate is \$66.00 plus tax for two queens and \$63.00 plus tax for a room with one king. They do allow dogs in the rooms and charge \$15.00 per dog per day. This block will be reserved until March 16th so please call and make your reservations as soon as you know your plans.

There will be a Welcome dinner Wednesday night at the grounds and we hope that you can join us for some visiting and catching up with those we haven't seen in a while. If you know that you will be able to attend the Welcome dinner please let us know when you send in your entry form. Late arrivals will be welcome at the Wednesday night dinner. We are going to have a banquet on Thursday night from an open menu at a local restaurant. Lunches will be available on the grounds each day for a nominal fee.
