Refunds

Requests for refunds may be given for a dog that becomes ill, injured or dies and for bitches in season upon receipt of a letter from a veterinarian. Refund requests must be made to the event secretary within 5 days of the last day of the trial. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by the action of the Judge(s) or Field Trial Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the Field Trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, inclement weather, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the host club.

Bitches in season are not allowed on the field trial grounds.
