ENTRIES

All tests are open to all AKC registerable breeds of flushing spaniels and Airedales and Flushing Spaniels and Airedales eligible to compete in the conformation Miscellaneous Class six months of age or older on the first day of the event.

Entry limited to Fifty (50) entries each day. Entries will close when the limit is reached, if this occurs prior to specified closing time.

Entry Fee: \$55.00 per dog, Junior, Senior or Master, each day. Entries **MUST** be signed and filled out completely. The appropriate AKC recording fees are included in the entry fee. Checks payable to FVECS must accompany all entries.

Entries will close at 5:00 PM CST, Wednesday, July 28, 2010, with the Hunt test secretary, at 739 S Quincy St. Green Bay WI. 54301-3626. ATTENTION PARTICIPANTS

NOTICE: Safety First! All participants **MUST WEAR BLAZE ORANGE** in the field and only gunners approved by the Hunt Test Committee will be used.

Training, correcting, or disciplining of dogs will not be permitted on the Hunt Test grounds. All dogs must be leashed or confined when not being tested.

The health, safety and well being of the dogs being of paramount importance, water pans to cool them down will be provided. When conditions in the opinion of either; Judges, Marshals or any member of the HT committee, require such cooling, dogs **MUST** be thoroughly wet down. Dogs not wet down and cooled sufficiently in the sole opinion of any of the above mentioned officials will **NOT** be allowed to run. There will be no refunds provided for such dogs.

TIME

Hunt Test schedule will be Junior fieldwork starting at 7:30 AM CDST. Junior water work to follow the conclusion of Junior field work. Senior fieldwork to follow Junior fieldwork, Master field work at 7:30 AM CDST. Hunt "deads" for Senior and Master after Master fieldwork. Senior and Master water work will follow conclusion of Senior and Master hunt "deads."

COURSES AND BIRDS

Pheasants and/or Chukars, Junior, Senior and Master Land and Water

AWARDS

Standard AKC Rosettes to all dogs receiving Qualifying Scores.

REFUNDS, SCRATCHES, NO SHOWS

Entry fees paid for a bitch withdrawn because of coming into season or for a dog withdrawn because of an injury or illness, or for a dog which dies, shall be refunded in full by the test giving club. Prior to paying such refund, the

club may require an appropriate veterinary certificate. Requests and documentation must be presented prior to the test. There will be no refunds for “no shows”. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is disqualified, excused by a judge or barred from the test by action of the Hunt Test Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the test cannot be started or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, an act of God, public emergency, or any other cause beyond the control of the Hunt Test Committee.

MOVE-UPS

Dogs may be moved up to a higher Test level (in a second event) if a title is acquired after entries have closed in the second Test, subject to the approval of the Hunting Test Committee of the second event, the availability of birds, payment of the difference, if any, in entry fees, and provided also that the dog is moved up at least one-half hour prior to the start of the second Test. Dogs so moved up will be placed at the end of the drawn running order.

From the South.... Take Hwy 57/32 north to Ott Rd, right on Ott Rd to Irish Rd. Follow Irish Rd to the Test Grounds
