ECSCA Field Trial Committee

Meeting Minutes: March 8, 2016, 8:00 PM EST

A. NCC Update

i. Report from NCC Chairperson, Chris Dartt

The 2016 NCC will be held in Foredo, MN, which is approximately 12 miles from the headquarters in Alexandria, MN. Alexandria is a nice size town with a good selection of hotels, restaurants, store, state parks, etc.

- Dates are Wednesday, October 26 through Saturday, October 29, with Sunday being reserved if needed. Training Day will be Tuesday, October 25, on a location close to the trial grounds.

- Headquarters will be the Holiday Inn in Alexandria, MN. The hotel has a conference room, a banquet room, and restaurant. Both the Welcome Party and the Banquet will be held on-site.

- A block of 30 rooms will be reserved for NCC at approximately \$90/room.

- Dogs are allowed in rooms and there is ample area to exercise them outdoors.

- Chris has an upcoming meeting set with the hotel to finalize prices for rooms, welcome party, and banquet. She is also trying to negotiate free rooms for our judges.

- Chris is currently working on acquiring a caterer for lunches.

- Private grounds will be used for the Trial, thus saving \$1000 in ground fees.
- Birds have been reserved (\$9/hen pheasant & \$13/cock pheasant) and they will be delivered to the grounds each night. Cock pheasants will be used for the 5th series.
- 1st and 2nd Series will be held in open fields; 3rd and 4th series in tree lines; 5th Series in grass field with small pine trees. Water will be held at a gravel pit with a clear gravel pond approximately 3 miles from the trial grounds.
- The estimated number of entries is 90 dogs.
- Chris is looking for a Fundraising Chair. Currently, a Silent Auction and Basket Raffle have been planned.
- Chris has also secured a list of individuals to take and process the shot birds and is currently working with the Head Marshall to ensure that all birds left in the field will be picked up.
- The location of the 2016 NCC is approximately 3 hours from Bismarck, ND, and 2 hours from Minneapolis, MN.

Vicky made two suggestions: 1) post a set of directions early so that NCC attendees have them prior to arrival. 2) Have food / snacks / hors d'oeuvres at the Awards Presentation.

ii. Promoting ECSCA Membership at NCC

Vicki suggested two possible ways to promote ECSCA Membership: 1) give ECSCA members free lunches at the NCC. (Chris felt this might be okay for *one* day, but would be difficult for 3 or 4 days.) 2) Distribute ECSCA patches for members to put on their vests.

iii. Agenda for Welcome Dinner & Banquet

FTC Chairman asked Chris Dartt to format an agenda/timeline for the Welcome Dinner and Banquet (i.e. meals, announcements, awards, etc). This would help streamline the events, ensuring important items don't get overlooked. It could also be passed down as a guide to assist future NCC Chairmen via the "How to Run an NCC."

iv. Gun Team

Vicky stated that since the NCC is the responsibility of the FTC, the FTC would like to see a list of the proposed 2016 Gun Team and have input regarding those selected.

Chris Dartt did not feel the FTC should be placing restrictions or forcing the NCC to use a list of pre-selected guns. She stated that the NCC Gun Captain should select the guns that he/she feels will do the absolute best and safest job. Chris also voiced concern that a gunning change happening in the middle of planning an NCC makes things difficult. She suggested 2016 Gun Captain, John Dartt, attend the next FTC meeting to help address these issues.

v. Posting of NCC Dates

Chris Dartt will be working with Nadine to post the dates for the NCC on the fieldcockers.com website.

B. Criteria for Judging Field Trials

- i. NCC Trial Judges:* The current criteria for judging an NCC is “3 AKC Cocker Trials in 2 separate venues”. *After further discussion and input, the 5 members of the FTC voted unanimously to change the requirement.*

Decision: Amended to: “a minimum of 3 AKC Cocker Trials in 3 separate venues”.

- ii. Regular Field Trial Judges:* A regular field trial must have judges with 12 points between them. The FTC voted to keep the minimum amount of venues for a Senior 12-point judge to continue to be 5 venues in order to judge with a new, inexperienced judge. **This motion passed unanimously.**

C. Compilation: List of Judges

Since the AKC is the source and rule for judging assignments, the FTC will use their list as a starting point. However, some of the data is incomplete, so updating, correcting, and ongoing management of this list will need to be done. In addition, the FTC is recommending a second list kept of those people who have completed, or need to complete, apprenticeships. This would assist those looking for judges to obtain qualified judges in the future.

REQUEST: Please contact Vicky if you would like to take charge of ‘Updating & Managing these Lists’.

D. Gun Committee

Input was received regarding broader representation on the Gunning Committee. The following was discussed: 1) the committee having broader representation across the country 2) regions and number of reps 3) using the most seasoned guns for the NCC.

B. Certificates of Merit: Trials with 30+ Dogs

The subject of adding ‘Certificates of Merit’ to field trials with over 30 dog entries was discussed. By adding **1 or 2 ‘Certificates of Merit’, plus a Gun’s Award**, this may encourage more handlers/owners to enter larger trials.

C. Number of Judges for Events with 3+ Trials per Venue

There are several trials that have multiple days (3 or 4) in a single venue. Some handlers feel they pay a lot of money to attend and don’t want to run the same course with the same set of judges over the course of 3 or 4 days.

Decision: While the FTC is hesitant to micro-manage clubs and their judging selections, they encourage all clubs to use common sense and make trials as exciting and different as possible for participants. It was suggested that, in the event a club is hosting a 3 or 4 day event, with both Open and Amateur trials, the Club could use their judges for the Open and then use Pro-Handlers, who are already there, to judge the Amateur stake. Additional costs would be limited, but handlers would get a different set of judges.

D. Approving ECSCA-sponsored Field Trial budgets

Karen Spurlin, Treasurer of the ECSCA, oversees the budget process for new clubs running a field trial under the ECSCA umbrella. This includes offering guidance in creating the budget, approving expenditures, and collecting & disbursing funds. A question was raised concerning whether the FTC should also have a role in approving these budgets, not only because of their expertise in running field trials, but since money lost on trials comes from the NCC account.

Judging Criteria for Judging Cocker Spaniel Field Trials

The following criteria are necessary requirements for judging AKC Member or Licensed Cocker Spaniel Field Trials.

1. Trial judging experience between the two Judges combined must meet a minimum of twelve (12) AKC Championship Stake judging assignments. The twelve (12) Championship Stake judging assignments must be AKC approved judging assignments and have occurred in at least 5 different venues. Championship Stakes are those that award points toward an AKC Field Champion title or AKC Amateur Field Champion title.
2. All judges wishing to judge Cocker Spaniel Field Trials shall receive a copy of the most recent addition of the "Green Book" *A Guide to the Conduct and judging of Cocker Spaniel Field trials*. They shall be asked to become familiar with its contents and address any questions they may have to the field trial chair person or committee. The most recent copy of the Green Book shall be supplied by the FTC Committee at no cost to the judge. (Paragraph added 2/9/2016 pending ECSCA BOD approval)
3. All judges agreeing to judge Cocker Spaniel Field Trials must complete two (2) Apprentice Judging Assignments under different judges, prior to judging. The Apprentice assignments shall be completed at an AKC Member or Licensed Spaniel Field Trial with prior approval from the local Field Trial Committee. The Apprentice Judge must be assigned to an AKC Senior Judge, an AKC spaniel field trial judge with 12 points of their own, with the Senior Judge agreeing to the assignment. The standard AKC Apprentice form must be filled out and approved/passed by the Senior Judge and submitted to the AKC for recording purposes **and a copy should also be supplied to the FTC Chairman.** (Amended 2/9/2016 pending ECSCA BOD approval)

The Apprentice Judging Program is an excellent way to develop prospective judges. It is also recognized and encouraged that local clubs take full advantage of mentoring new judges or judges with less experience and pairing them with Senior Judges that have had extensive field trial experience. The idea being to grow and develop new prospective judge's numbers and knowledge while we have the opportunity to benefit from those experienced judges.

4. The Spaniel Field Trial Judging seminar must be completed prior to apprenticing at a field trial. (Amended 1/26/16 pending ECSCA BOD approval.)

Judges with prior AKC Field Trial Spaniel Championship stake judging experience will be grandfathered in and only new or prospective individuals interested in judging are required to complete an Apprentice Program and attend a Spaniel Judging Seminar.

NCC Judges selection criteria is as follows:

In addition to the judging criteria for Cocker Spaniel Field Trials, individuals being considered for NCC Judges must:

1. Have judged a minimum of twelve (12) AKC Championship Spaniel Field Trial stakes, of which at least three (3) must be AKC Cocker Spaniel Field Trial Championship stakes **in at least three (3) separate venues.** (Amended 1/26/16 and 3/8/16 pending ECSCA BOD approval.)

2. Have Field Championed or, shared by handling the earning of points toward the FC or AFC title of a spaniel.
3. Has actively handled a spaniel in an AKC field trial in the past three (3) years prior to the NCC they would be judging.

Cocker field trial judges should have experience and knowledge in Cocker Spaniel handling, training, or prior judging assignments to enhance the judging panel.

It is essential that judges be of the highest standard possible, active in all phases of Spaniel training, trialing and handling.
