For permanent possession, it must be won five times by identical owner(s), not necessarily with the same dog, nor at consecutive events. The trophy will remain in possession of the ECSCA until such time as it is awarded. A commemorative engraved plaque with club logo will be awarded to each National Cocker Championship winner.

The "Fallen Wings Breeder's Cup" - a crystal vase on wood base, offered by Michael and Rumi Schroeder to the breeder of the dog/bitch winning the National Cocker Championship. A suitable trophy will be offered as the Commemorative to the Fallen Wings Breeder's Cup by Michael and Rumi Schroeder, to be won outright. Possession to be retained by the ECSCA or the donors until terms of possession have been met.
